
OWNERS' BEHIND CLOSED DOORS ARRANGEMENTS



The "Owners Zone" is a dedicated zone which is separate from other raceday workers (trainers, stable staff, jockeys, officials etc) with no movement between the two unless for raceday personnel (i.e. cleaning team).

In line with Government Guidance, Owners have been advised that face coverings are not mandatory on racecourses but are asked to adhere to the BHA's social distancing advice of 2 meters.



PRE- SCREENING: Online Educational Module, Health Questionnaire, pre-registered with PASS System. Max 2 Owners allowed per declared horse.

ARRIVAL SCREENING: Temperature Check, Photo ID shown and Owners accreditation issued.

ARRIVAL TIME: no sooner than 45 mins before declared horse's race

VEHICLE PARKING: Course Enclosure off West Dyke Road. Entry via Cobble Gates. The postcode for SatNavs is TS10 4HJ.

TESTING & PEDESTRIAN ENTRANCE: From the car park proceed towards the track to the Owners' Entrance & testing station. Once testing has been completed and accreditation received proceed to the course crossing point to access the Owners' zone in the Paddock Suite.

OWNERS' ZONE: the Paddock Suite Bar on the ground floor has views over the course, and the balconies on the first floor overlook the parade ring, track and have a distant view of the Winners' Enclosure. The Paddock Suite has internal toilet facilities.

RACE VIEWING: from the Paddock Suite balcony or trackside viewing area directly outside the Paddock Suite secured by crowd barriers.

REFRESHMENTS: available from the Paddock Suite Bar.

DEBRIEF AREA: the debrief area (double barrier) is located in the area between the Paddock Suite, Zetland Bar and Parade Ring.

NO ACCESS allowed to the Parade Ring, Winners' Enclosure, Weighing Room or Stables.

SANITISER STATIONS are at the Owners' Entrance / Exit, and at the Paddock Suite entrances and inside the facility.

DEPARTURE TIME: no later than 1 hour after their horse's race.

PEDESTRIAN EXIT: Exit through one way of the Owners' Exit.

VEHICLE EXIT: Exit the Centre Course via the Rose Garden Gates onto West Dyke Road.
